
St. Andrew's Becomes a Year-round Church





Beginning in 1987, St. Andrew's began to hold off-season services at the United Congregational Church in the Ladies Parlor. At first, there were fewer than a dozen in attendance at these services.

Under the leadership of the Reverend Hébert Bolles, a retired U. S. Navy chaplain, the congregation soon outgrew the Ladies Parlor and moved to a larger space within the United Congregational Church, the Undercroft. Summer services continued at the chapel.







In 1992, as a first step towards having a presence at The Commons, space was rented in the Guild Building for the church office. In 1995, St. Andrew's began holding all off-season services in the Guild Building. The left photo shows worship space where the altar is currently located.
